Happy Mother's Day!

This Mother's Day and May Bulletin is sponsored by the Sisterhood of St Nicholas Church in honor and celebration of Mother's Day for all our parish mothers, and in memory of all the departed mothers and sisters of our Parish. Happy Mother's Day!

Commentary: This verse is read at Baptism, and also on Holy Saturday. It reminds us that we who have been baptized in Christ are an entirely new creature, and we walk in the newness of the Holy Spirit. Thus this is an appropriate passage for this Paschal period and for Pentecost.

Services

Mid-Pentecost: Vespers for Mid-Pentecost will be at 6:30 pm Tuesday 8 May, and will be followed immediately by the *Lesser Blessing of Waters*.

Armed Forces Day: There will be a moleben for our soldiers in the Armed Forces at 3:30 pm Saturday 19 May, before Vigil. Please pray for our soldiers who are in the field of battle.

Ascension: Vigil with Litya at 6:30 pm Wednesday 23 May, and Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am Thursday 24 May. This marks the end of the Paschal period and is one of the major holy days of the Orthodox Church.

Troparion, Tone 4: *Thou didst ascend in glory, O Christ our God, having granting joy to Thy disciples through the promise of the Holy Spirit. Through the blessing they were assured that Thou art the Son of God, the Redeemer of the world.*

Kontakion, Tone 6: *When Thou didst fulfill Thy dispensation for our sake, uniting things on earth with the heavens, Thou didst ascend in glory O Christ our God, not being parted from them that love Thee, but remaining with them and crying, I am with you, and no one shall be against you.*

Soul Saturday: The final Memorial Saturday in the year is on the Eve of Pentecost. We will serve a General Pannychida at 3 pm Saturday 11 June. We will read all the Commemoration Lists at the Candle Desk. If you wish to add the names of any loved ones, please leave them at the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy on Sunday 27 May.

Lesser Holy Days: To celebrate lesser holy days in May, we will serve the following services: *St Mark the Evangelist*, Moleben at 6:30 pm Monday 7 May; *St John the Theologian*, Moleben at 6:30 pm Monday 21 May; and *Translation of the Relics of St Nicholas* at 6:30 pm Tuesday 22 May. The latter celebrates the transfer of the relics of our patron Saint from Myra in Asia Minor (now Turkey) to Bari, Italy, to keep them in the hands of the faithful, and to protect them from enemies of the Church. As a feast of St Nicholas it is the secondary Feast of our Parish. We will have the actual Relic of our own Patron Saint available for veneration at the Moleben.

Memorial Day: In observance of Memorial Day, Monday 28 May, we will have a Memorial Service at the end of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 27 May for all Orthodox soldiers that died in battle, and we also ask our parishioners to remember in their private prayers all non-Orthodox who perished and gave their lives for the defense of freedom, and that the Lord may have mercy on them. Please remember to display the flag Monday.

Blessing of Homes: If you missed your scheduled time before Lent and still wish to have your house blessed, please contact Fr George and set up an appointment.

Blessing of Graves: If you were not able to be present at the stated time at the cemetery for the blessing of the grave of a loved one, or if you have a loved one buried elsewhere, you may contact Fr George to arrange the blessing of the grave at another time.

Announcements – May 2012

Pentecost: This is one of the 12 Great Feasts. Vigil with Litya will be at 5 pm Saturday 2 June, and the Divine Liturgy for the Feast at 10 am on Sunday 3 June. The Divine Liturgy will be immediately followed by Vespers for Pentecost with the Kneeling Prayers. The Vespers service is only about 45 minutes long and contains seven prayers read in three groups asking the Holy Spirit to descend on us and on the Church and to keep us under His protection.

Pentecost Week: Because of the joy of the Feast, the week following Pentecost is fast-free, and therefore we may eat meat even on Wednesday and Friday 6 and 8 June.

Apostles' Fast: This fast begins on the day after the Sunday of All Saints, that is to say Monday 11 June and ends on the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul, Thursday 12 July. The beginning of this fast depends on the date of Pascha, and so this year this fast is three weeks long. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products, and on Wednesdays and Fridays also from fish, wine and oil. If you have not kept the fast before, now is a good time to begin, for this is an easy fast. Try at least to keep away from meat, and then if possible, eggs and dairy. The important thing is to make improvements, and to do better every time.

Our Parish

Fr George Away: Fr George, Matushka Ann and their family will be away on Sunday 13 May, Mother's Day. Fr Vadim Pismenny will substitute for Fr George. We ask our parishioners to support Fr Vadim by attending the Liturgy, and welcoming him. We will still greet the mothers of our Parish for Mother's Day.

Relics of Saints: We thank Fr John Perich of St Herman of Alaska Church in Boothwyn, Pennsylvania, for the gift to our parish on Sunday 25 March of the relics of *St Nicholas of Zhicha* (Serbian bishop active in America) and *St Nectarios of Pentapolis*. We also thank Fr John for his previous gift of the Relic of our own *Patron Saint, Nicholas, Archbishop of Myra in Lycia*, which he gave us on Sunday 18 December 2011, as we celebrated our Parish Feast. We will present the Relics of St Nicholas of Myra for veneration during the Moleben for the Transfer of his Relics on Tuesday 22 May.

Holy Week and Pascha: We thank all those who helped with cleanup and preparation and the decoration of the Tomb of our Lord during Holy Week and on Pascha: Ann Sharog, Eugene Kallaur, Anastasia Milligan, Thomas Milligan, Martin Hudobenko, Joan Hudobenko, John Lardas, Alexandra Trahan, and others. We also thank those who remained behind on Pascha night and set things up while the procession circled the church. *Christ is risen! Христосъ Воскресе!*

Brasswork: We thank Fr Deacon Paul Giatas who polished the brasswork so beautifully in preparation for Pascha.

Pussy Willows: We thank Matushka Ann for donating the pussy willows for Palm Sunday.

Candle Desk Duty: We need people to watch the Candle Desk, handle donations, light candles, and ring the bell during

services – one person for Vigil and two for the Divine Liturgy. Unfortunately, we are not always able to find people for all positions. It is sad for visitors to come and find no parishioners to greet them, but only the servers and singers. Please sign up if you are able to come.

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

Consider the Church in Your Will: Please consider including St Nicholas Church in your will. There are many advantages in making the Church one of your beneficiaries. Utilities: Please remember that on the *first Sunday* of each month there is a special collection for *utilities*.

The Weekly Announcements include the hymns sung that Sunday and the Epistle and Gospel readings.

Sisterhood

Coffee Hour Supplies: The Sisterhood again is in need of donations of supplies for our Coffee Hour. We need paper plates, Styrofoam soup bowls, cups, and paper napkins. Our Children

Mother's Day: This is the second Sunday of May, the 13th. We will honor the mothers of our parish with carnations handed out by the Church School children. Please note that Fr George will not be present, Fr Vadim Pismenny will be serving in his place.

Church School Graduation: This will take place at the end of the Divine Liturgy on the Sunday of All Saints, which is the Sunday after Pentecost, 10 June, along with a moleben to mark the end of the school year. We ask all Church School children and their teachers to attend. We will also congratulate all graduates in our parish from all schools or colleges. If you have children in school and wish to have their names commemorated, please submit them to the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy of that day.

St Seraphim's Orthodox Summer Camp: The eighteenth year of St Seraphim Russian Orthodox Youth Camp has been announced. The camp is open to all children of the Russian Orthodox Church and will take place July 29 through August 6, which includes the feast of St Seraphim of Sarov. The cost is \$275.00 per child, but will increase to \$300 after July 5, so register early.

Each year, over 200 participate, making the camp the largest youth activity of the Russian Church Abroad. Each day begins with morning prayer and is filled with wonderful activities such as the Law of God, hiking, tube rafting, sports, arts and crafts, and bonfires. Evening prayers end the day. Each campsite is supervised by adult counselors as well as college-aged junior counselors. Several priests spend the entire week at camp, offering counseling, prayers, and instruction. All instruction is in English and services are in both English and Church Slavonic. Vigil and Liturgy are served the final weekend and all children receive the Holy Mysteries.

This is an opportunity for our children to experience summer activities with other Orthodox children from other parishes and leads to life-long friendships. Our Albany and Wilkes-Barre parishes are especially active in the camp. The deadline for camp applications is 5 July but it often fills up fast. Liturgical Notes

White: The white cloths and vestments remain until the end of Pentecost week, 18 June.

Carnations: Before the Liturgy on Mother's day, Sunday 13 May, a bunch of carnations are placed in the church for the children of the Church School to hand to the mothers in the parish as they come to kiss the Cross.

Holy Water: Before the Vespers of Mid-Pentecost, Tuesday 18 May, a vat of water is prepared for the Blessing of Waters that will take place at that service.

Plaschanitsa: This is put away on the eve of Ascension, Wednesday 1 June.

Sign: The *Christ is Risen* sign is removed on the Eve of Ascension, Wednesday 1 June.

Green: Green vestments are used from the Vigil of Pentecost, Saturday 2 June through the end of Pentecost Week. If green is not available, we use white.

Greens and Branches: On Saturday afternoon, 2 June, before the Vigil on the eve of Pentecost, the church is decorated with branches of birch and other trees to remind us of the newness of life in the Holy Spirit. We need the men in our parish to help cut the branches.

Red: Before Vigil on the eve of All Saints, Saturday 9 June, all the altar cloths are changed to red and the red vestments are set out. The red remains until the eve of Ss Peter and Paul, Tuesday afternoon, 11 July. *The red cloths should be dry cleaned during the Paschal period, so that they may be ready before Pentecost.*

Gold: Before Vigil on the eve of Ss Peter and Paul, Tuesday 11 July, all the altar cloths are changed to gold and the gold vestments are set out. The gold remains until the eve of the Dormition Fast, Sunday 13 August.
