Services

Moleben: We will serve a Moleben to Ss Constantine and Helen at 6:30 pm Monday 3 June.

Brenda Hall Memorial: At the end of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 9 June, we will serve a Pannychida in memory of our beloved Senior Sister, Brenda Hall. Her family and friends will sponsor the Coffee Hour in her memory.

Ascension: Vigil with Litya at 6:30 pm Wednesday 12 June, and Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am Thursday 13 June. This marks the end of the Paschal period and is one of the major holy days of the Orthodox Church, and all who are able to attend the services should do so.

Soul Saturday: The final Memorial Saturday in the year is on the Eve of Pentecost. We will serve a General Pannychida at 3 pm Saturday 22 June. We will read all the Commemoration Lists at the Candle Desk. If you wish to add the names of any loved ones, please leave them at the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy on Sunday 16 June.

Pentecost: This is one of the 12 Great Feasts. Vigil with Litya will be at 5 pm Saturday 22 June, and the Divine Liturgy for the Feast at 10 am on Sunday 23 June. The Divine Liturgy will be immediately followed by Vespers for Pentecost with the Kneeling Prayers. The Vespers service is only about 45 minutes long and contains seven prayers read in three groups asking the Holy Spirit to descend on us and on the Church and to keep us under His protection. While we read these prayers alternating languages, we do not repeat them. They are each read only once.

Pentecost Week: Because of the joy of the Feast, the week following Pentecost (23-29 June) is fast-free, and therefore we may eat meat, eggs and dairy products even on Wednesday and Friday 26 and 28 June.

St John Maximovitch: We will serve Vespers to St John Maximovitch, Archbishop of Shanghai and San Francisco at 6:30 pm Friday 28 June. There will be no Divine Liturgy on Saturday 29 June.

Apostles' Fast: This fast begins on the day after the Sunday of All Saints, that is to say Monday 1 July and ends on the Feast of Ss Peter and Paul, Friday 12 July. The beginning of this fast depends on the date of Pascha, and so this year this fast is just under two weeks (11 days) long. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products, and on Wednesdays and Fridays also from fish, wine and oil. If you have not kept the fast before, now is a good time to begin, for this is an easy fast. Try at least to keep away from meat, and then if possible, eggs and

dairy. The important thing is to make improvements, and to do better every time.

Blessing of Homes: If you missed your scheduled time before Lent and still wish to have your house blessed, please contact Fr George and set up an appointment.

Blessing of Graves: If you were not able to be present at the scheduled time at the cemetery for the blessing of the grave of a loved one, or if you have a loved one buried elsewhere, you may contact Fr George to set up an appointment to bless the grave.

Our Parish

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

Utilities: Please remember that on the *first Sunday* of each month there is a special collection for *utilities*.

Consider the Church in Your Will: Please consider including St Nicholas Church in your will. There are many advantages in making the Church one of your beneficiaries. Our Children

Church School Graduation: In connection with the Brotherhood's Shashlik Picnic, we will hold the Church School Graduation on Sunday 9 June after the Divine Liturgy. We ask all Church School children and their teachers to attend. The Graduation will be followed by the Brotherhood's Shashlik Picnic. We will also congratulate all graduates in our parish from all schools or colleges. If you have children in school and wish to have their names commemorated, please submit them to the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy of that day.

St Seraphim's Orthodox Summer Camp: The nineteenth year of St Seraphim Russian Orthodox Youth Camp has been announced. The camp is open to all children of the Russian Orthodox Church and will take place July 28 through August 4, which includes the feast of St Seraphim of Sarov. The cost remains at \$275.00 per child, but will increase to \$300 after July 5, so register early.

Each year, over 200 participate, making the camp the largest youth activity of the Russian Church Abroad. Each day begins with morning prayer and is filled with wonderful activities such as the Law of God, hiking, tube rafting, sports, arts and crafts, and bonfires. Evening prayers end the day. Each campsite is supervised by adult counselors as well as college-aged junior counselors. Several priests spend the entire week at camp, offering counseling, prayers, and instruction. All instruction is in English and services are in both English and Church Slavonic. Vigil and Liturgy are served the final weekend and all children receive the Holy Mysteries.

This is an opportunity for our children to experience summer activities with other Orthodox children from other parishes and

leads to life-long friendships. Our Albany and Wilkes-Barre parishes are especially active in the camp. The deadline for camp applications is 5 July but it often fills up fast. Question and Answer

Q: *I was wondering, should I include my own name when I hand in a list for health and salvation to be commemorated at the Proskomedia of the Liturgy? It feels strange for me to do so, but I would still like the prayers.*

A: You may certainly include your own name in your commemoration list. The purpose of the list is to remember those names at the preparation and consecration of the Lord's Supper. And it is our fervent and dearest prayer that we should partake of that Supper in the everlasting Kingdom of our Lord together with all the ones that we love, in health and in fullness of joy. In the Prayers before Communion we ask, Remember me, O Lord, in Thy Kingdom. We list the names of our loved ones to be remembered, and we hope and pray and desire that the Lord will remember us also. In fact, when I read the names sent into the Altar, if I notice that the sender's name is not included, I mention that also. So please, feel free to include your own name.

Did You Know?

According to an article in *AARP The Magazine*, February/March 2013, p 36, people that live in a faith-based community and attend services more than once a week live as many as seven years longer than those that do not. Perhaps this is because we put our hope and trust in the Giver of life. The Holy Scriptures tell us that one day out of seven is sacred to God. This does not mean merely two hours' attendance at the Liturgy, but the whole day (24 hours). Accordingly, we have two services on the Lord's Day, which begins at sundown the night before with Vigil, as well as the Divine Liturgy on Sunday morning. Research shows that attendance at Divine Services is not only good for the soul, but it is also good for the body!

Liturgical Notes

Plaschanitsa and Sign: The Plaschanitsa on the Holy Table in the Altar is removed above the Royal Doors that reads *Христосъ Воскресе (Christ is Risen)* is taken down and the before Vigil for Ascension on Wednesday 22 June.

White: The white altar cloths and vestments remain until the end of Pentecost week, 29 June.

Green: Green vestments are used from the Vigil of Pentecost, Saturday 22 June through the end of Pentecost Week. If green is not available, we use white.

Greens and Branches: On Saturday afternoon, 22 June, before the Vigil on the eve of Pentecost, the church is decorated with branches of birch and other trees to remind us of the newness of life in the Holy Spirit. We need the men in our parish to help cut the branches.

Red: Before Vigil on the eve of All Saints, Saturday 29 June, all the altar cloths are changed to red and the red vestments are set out. The red remains until the eve of Ss Peter and Paul, Thursday afternoon, 11 July.

Gold: Before Vigil on the eve of Ss Peter and Paul, Thursday 11 July, all the altar cloths are changed to gold and the gold vestments are set out. The gold remains until the eve of the Dormition Fast, Sunday 13 August.
