The bulletin costs about \$1.25 each to produce and receiving the bulletin via email will save money for our parish. We also invite our readers to support this Bulletin by donations.

**Weekly Announcements:** At the end of the Liturgy Fr George gives the weekly announcements from the Ambo. But not all are present when the announcements are made. If you wish to receive a weekly email copy of the Announcements, please send Fr George an email at [frglardas@gmail.com](mailto:frglardas@gmail.com), and your name will be added to the distribution. The Weekly Announcements include the hymns sung that Sunday and the Epistle and Gospel readings.

**Do you wish to be taken off our mailing list?** Please contact us and we will remove your name from our monthly bulletin mailing.

**Become a Member:** If you attend services but are not a member, would you please consider joining? The cost is not great - \$150 per adult, or \$300 for families with two adults and any number of children. This amounts to about \$12.50 a month per person. We also have an introductory rate for students.

### Services

**Nativity Fast (Advent):** The Nativity Fast began on Thursday 28 November and continues until Christmas Day, 7 January. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products. On Wednesdays and Fridays we also abstain from fish, wine and oil. Some keep a strict fast Mondays. The fast becomes stricter on the day after Ss Spyridon and Herman, 25 December, after which we do not eat fish until Christmas Day.

**Entry of the Mother of God:** This is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church. Vigil with Litya will be at 6:30 pm on Tuesday 3 December. Divine Liturgy will be at 9:30 am on Wednesday 4 December. This is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church year.

**St Nicholas Day:** Our Parish Feast falls on Thursday 19 December. Vigil with Litya will be at 6:30 pm Wednesday 18 December; and Divine Liturgy will be at 9:30 am on Thursday 19 December. The parish will celebrate with a Fish Dinner after the Liturgy on Sunday 15 December.

**Molebens:** We will serve a moleben for the rest of the lesser holy days in December: *St Catherine* – 3 pm Saturday 7 December; *Kursk Root Icon* – 6:30 pm Tuesday 10 December; *St Andrew the First-Called* – 6:30 pm Friday 13 December; and *St Barbara* – 6:30 pm Tuesday 17 December.

**Ss Herman & Spyridon:** This day, which is also secular Christmas, falls on a Thursday. As the St Herman Conference will be held close by, on Long Island, we encourage our people to attend services for St Herman. The schedule will be announced before the event.

### Our Parish

**Tatiana Sergievsky:** A Pannychida for the Fortieth Day since her repose will be served after the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 1 December.

**St Nicholas Day:** Our Parish Feast falls on Thursday 19 December. We will have the traditional St Nicholas Day Fish Dinner after the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 15 December, but we will have Vigil and Divine Liturgy on the eve and the very day of the Feast as mentioned in the Services section of this Bulletin.

**Christmas Flower Donations:** Please make note of the collection box in the center of the church; It its being used for flower donations to make the church beautiful for Christmas.

**Rectory Telephone Discontinued:** Land-line telephone service to the rectory at telephone number 203 386-9516 that rings in Fr George's house has been discontinued. If you wish to contact Fr George, please use his cell phone number, 203 209-9374, instead.

**Lampada Sponsorship:** Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. ### Community Notes

**Do Not Throw Away Old Medicine!** As of Saturday 19 October, a medication drop box for the safe disposal of both over-the-counter and prescription medicines will be open at all times, day and night, in the lobby of the *Stratford Police Department*. Keep drugs out of our water supply and out of the hands of children.

### Liturgical Notes

**Note:** This section is included in our Bulletin so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.

**Red:** On Wednesday afternoon, 27 November, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Red for the beginning of the Nativity Fast. They remain until the eve of the Feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, Tuesday 3 December.

**Blue:** For the feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, we use blue for all altar cloths and vestments from the eve of the Feast, Tuesday 3 December, until the leave-taking of the Feast on Sunday 8 December. We also use blue for the Kursk-Root Icon, Sunday 9 and Monday 10 December.

**Red:** On Tuesday 11 December we change all altar cloths and vestments to Red for the continuation of the Nativity Fast. The red remains until Christmas Eve, 6 January.

**White:** After Liturgy on Christmas Eve, Monday 6 January we change all altar cloths and vestments to white. The white remains until the Apodosis (Leave-Taking) of Theophany, Monday 27 January.

**Decorations:** On Christmas Eve, Monday 6 January we decorate the church with poinsettias and lights.
