General Parish Meeting

This year's Annual General Parish Meeting will take place after the Divine Liturgy on **Sunday 2 February**. We invite all our members to attend and participate. Please remember that those eligible to vote are those who have confessed and received Communion at least once in the past year and who are up to date in their dues. If you wish to participate, please be sure to fulfill your obligations.

Council Meeting: A meeting of the Parish Council in preparation for the General Meeting will take place on **Sunday 26 January**. We ask all Parish Council Members to attend.

Annual Dues: We ask our parishioners who are not current in their dues please see our Treasurer, Anastasia Milligan. These dues help maintain our parish and give us the privilege of voting and making our voice heard at the Annual Parish Meeting. Donations over and above the dues are also most welcome.

Become a Member: If you attend services but are not a member, would you please consider joining? The cost is not great – \$150 per adult, or \$300 for families with two adults and any number of children. This amounts to about \$12.50 a month per person. We have an introductory rate for students.

Election of Parish Officers: This will take place at the Annual General Parish Meeting on Sunday 2 February. Please let Dexter Peavy (203 387-8744) know if you would like to join the church council. A list of candidates will be posted at the church door before the election.

Inauguration: The inauguration of the Parish Officers will take place the following Sunday, 9 March. All Parish Council Members should prepare by Confession and Communion on that day.

Sponsor the Coffee Hour: The Sisterhood is happy to hold the Coffee Hour every Sunday for the sake of fellowship and the community of our Parish. However, we find the same ladies working in the kitchen Sunday after Sunday. Since many of our Sisterhood are no longer so young and able, we are seeking volunteers to give the ladies in the Sisterhood a rest so that they may attend the Divine Liturgy in peace.

We need families or individuals (men can do this too!) to take responsibility for preparing and serving a meal on a rotating basis. Ideally this responsibility would not fall more than once every six weeks or so, and so it would not be a great burden. This is also an opportunity to showcase our culinary skills. It is a Christian duty to support the Parish, and there is much blessing in it. To sign up see Joan Hudobenko.

Bliny: Our annual *Bliny* luncheon will be after the Divine Liturgy on the Sunday of Meat Fare at the beginning of Cheese-Fare Week (*Maslenitsa*), 23 February. Please support the Sisterhood by attending and participating in this delicious meal.

Services

Inclement Weather: Winter sometimes brings stormy weather. We ask our parishioners to use good judgment and common sense not to drive when conditions are dangerous. As weather varies from place to place, it may be that services will be held as scheduled, despite the fact that conditions in your area are difficult. To find out whether services are cancelled or delayed, call 203 / 375-4793. If you hear the usual greeting, services will be held as scheduled. Otherwise the message will inform you whether services are cancelled or delayed. In general, if Fr George can arrive at the church, services will be held however many or few people are present. Weather advisories will also be posted on our Parish website, www.StNicholasStratford.org.

Daylight Time Begins: Please remember that Daylight Time begins at 2 am Sunday 9 March. Please set your clocks ahead one hour on Saturday evening 8 March, so as not to be late for church!

Blessing of Homes: Starting on Theophany Day, Sunday 19 January, Fr George will be blessing homes with Holy Water. The schedule of house blessings is attached to this bulletin.

Time of Vigil during House Blessings: On Saturdays while Fr George is blessing houses with Holy Water, the time of Vigil is temporarily moved to 6:30 pm. This is definite for Saturdays **25 January, 1 February** and **1 March**, and may include others to be announced. When Fr George is not blessing houses on Saturday, Vigil will revert to the usual time, 5 pm.

Work Schedule: Fr George works part-time as an adjunct professor and professional tutor at the University of New Haven and at the University of Bridgeport. His hours are

- Mondays: 3-5 pm
- Tuesdays: 9 am – 6 pm
- Wednesdays: 10 am – 5 pm
- Thursday: 9 am – 6 pm
- Fridays: 9 am – 3 pm

The term will end on Friday 16 May. Although it is possible for him to trade hours with someone else if needed, this is difficult. Accordingly, Fr George is unavailable for services public or private at those times. The schedule of services in this and following Bulletins will reflect this. In case of emergency call his cell phone, 203 209-9374, and leave a message, and he will return your call at the earliest opportunity.

Presentation of our Lord in the Temple: Metropolitan Hilarion will lead services for Parish Feast of our sister parish, the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. Vigil is at 7 pm on Friday 14 February, and Meeting of the Bishop at 9:30 am Saturday 15 February. There will be no services of the Presentation at St Nicholas. ***We encourage all our parishioners to attend services at the Presentation Church.*** We congratulate Archpriest Andrei Semyanko, and Fr Constantine Semyanko, and all the parishioners of Presentation Church with their Parish Feast.

Molebens: We mark lesser holy days in February with molebens. A moleben to *St Xenia* will be held at 7 pm Thursday 6 February. This will be later than usual due to Fr George's work schedule. A moleben to the Three Hierarchs will be held at 6:30 pm Wednesday 12 February.

General Pannychida: The Saturday before Meat Fare Sunday is a general commemoration of the dead. The General Pannychida for the repose of all souls that have died in the Lord will be at 3 pm Saturday 22 February. We will read the names of the reposed from all the Commemoration Books (*Pomjanniki*) at the Candle Desk. If you wish to add any names to the commemoration of the reposed, please leave your list at the Candle Desk the Sunday before, 16 February.

Forgiveness Sunday: Forgiveness Vespers will be immediately after the Divine Liturgy on Forgiveness Sunday 2 March. This is our opportunity to ask each other's forgiveness for any

offence knowing or unknowing that we may have committed over the past year, and so to begin Great Lent with a clean slate. The service is not very long, and for those that have difficulty standing through two services, it is permissible to come to the Liturgy late that day. Those that cannot kneel should not feel obliged to do so; those that can should.

Great Lent: This year Great Lent begins on Monday 3 March. During Lent we abstain from meat, eggs, dairy products, and fish. On weekdays we also abstain from wine and oil. Let us also abstain from every sin, and increase our efforts for spiritual growth. We should increase prayer, attendance at the special Lenten services, almsgiving and other deeds of mercy. Lent is given to us to cleanse our hearts and souls in preparation for our Lord's Resurrection.

Chronicle

Cancellations and Postponements in January: Due to Fr George's illness, the moleben scheduled for St Seraphim of Sarov on Tuesday 15 January and the Royal Hours on Friday 17 January, were cancelled.

Also due to illness, the first two days of scheduled house blessings, Sunday 19 January in Stratford were postponed to Sunday 16 February, and those scheduled for Monday 20 January in Milford were postponed to Sunday 23 February.

Sisterhood

Our Children

Forgiveness Sunday: Sunday 2 March, Church School will be shortened so that the children and their teachers may attend Forgiveness Vespers immediately at the end of the Divine Liturgy. We ask parents and parishioners not to make other commitments for this time.

Sunday of Orthodoxy: Our Church School will participate in a short moleben at the end of the Divine Liturgy on 9 March, the First Sunday of Great Lent. This celebrates the Triumph of Orthodoxy and the Restoration of the Icons. This replaces the regular classes of that day.

Food Drive: The Food Drive for the Sterling House Food Pantry will resume during Lent. Our Church School will lead this effort. We ask the parents in our parish to help out by sending food, canned goods and hygienic supplies with their children when they come to church. More information will be posted in the March Bulletin.

Liturgical Notes

Note: This section is included in our Bulletin so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.

White: After Liturgy on Christmas Eve, Monday 6 January we change all altar cloths and vestments to white. The white remains until the Apodosis (Leave-Taking) of Theophany, Monday 27 January.

Gold: After the leave-taking of the Feast of Theophany, Tuesday 27 January, we change the altar cloths and vestments to gold. They remain gold until the eve of the Presentation of our Lord.

Blue: On the eve of the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord, Friday 14 February, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to blue. They remain until the Apodosis of the Feast on Saturday 22 February.

Gold: On Saturday afternoon, 22 February, we return to gold altar cloths and vestments.

Black: We change all the altar cloths and vestments to black during Forgiveness Vespers, which are held immediately after the Liturgy on Sunday 2 March. The black cloths will have been placed under the gold ones ahead of time. We use black from Sunday nights through Friday afternoons of Lent. While the black cloths are used, the red ones are hidden underneath for the next Lenten weekend services.

Dark Red or Purple: The altar cloths and vestments are red from Friday evenings through Sunday evenings of Lent, purple vestments may be used as well. While the red cloths are used, the black ones are hidden underneath for the next Lenten weekday service.
