Services

First Weekend in May: Fr George and Matushka will be away at a wedding on the first weekend in May. Services will be held as usual: Vigil 5 pm Saturday 3 May, and Divine Liturgy 10 am Sunday 4 May. Fr Constantine DesRosiers of St Xenia's Parish in Methuen MA will serve, assisted by Fr Deacon Paul Giatas, and Peter Clegg from Norwich will conduct the choir. We ask all our people to help them and welcome them to our St Nicholas Church.

Translation of the Relics of St Nicholas: This celebrates the transfer of the Relics of our Patron Saint from Myra in Asia Minor (now Turkey) to Bari, Italy, to keep them in the hands of the faithful, and to protect them from the enemies of the Church. This feast falls on Thursday 22 May. As a feast of St Nicholas, it is

the secondary Feast of our Parish. We have the actual Relic of our own Patron Saint, which will be set out for veneration at Vespers on the eve, which begins at 6:30 pm Wednesday 21 May.

Mid-Pentecost: Vespers for Mid-Pentecost will be at 6:30 pm Tuesday 13 May, and will be followed immediately by the *Lesser Blessing of Waters*.

Armed Forces Day: We will serve a Moleben for our soldiers in the Armed Forces at 3 pm on Saturday 17 May. Please pray for our soldiers who are in the field of battle. We have a few (Orthodox and non-Orthodox) listed in our Prayer Requests section.

Ascension: Vigil with Litya at 6:30 pm Wednesday 28 May, and Divine Liturgy at 9:30 am Thursday 29 May. This marks the end of the Paschal period and is one of the major holy days of the Orthodox Church, and all who are able to attend the services should do so.

Memorial Day: In observance of Memorial Day, Monday 26 May, we will have a Memorial Service at the end of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 25 May for all Orthodox soldiers that died in battle, and we also ask our parishioners to remember in their private prayers all non-Orthodox who perished and gave their lives for the defense of freedom, and that the Lord may have mercy on them. Please remember to display the flag Monday.

Lesser Holy Days: To celebrate lesser holy days in May, we will serve molebens at the following times: *St George*, 6:30 pm Tuesday 6 May; *St Mark the Evangelist*, 6:30 pm Thursday 8 May; *St John the Theologian*, 6:30 pm Tuesday 20 May; and *Ss Cyril and Methodius*, 3 pm Saturday 24 May.

Blessing of Homes: If Fr. George was unable to bless your home before Lent and you still wish to have your house blessed, please contact Fr George and we will set up an appointment at a convenient time.

Blessing of Graves: If you are not able to be present at the scheduled time at the cemetery for the blessing of the grave of a loved one, or if you have a loved one not in any of the listed cemeteries, please contact Fr George to arrange a time to do this.

Collection Box: Starting with Pascha the collection box next to the icon stand in the middle of the church is for the Restoration Fund and preparations for our 85th Anniversary as a *community*. Our anniversary celebration will be on November 1 and 2.

Our Children

Mothers Day: This is the second Sunday of May, the 11th. We will honor the mothers of our parish with carnations handed out by the Church School children.

Church School Graduation: This will take place on the Sunday after Pentecost (All Saints), 15 June after the Divine Liturgy. We ask all Church School children and their teachers to attend. We will also congratulate all graduates in our parish from all schools or colleges. If you have children in school and wish to have their names commemorated, please submit them to the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy of that day.

St Seraphim's Orthodox Summer Camp: The nineteenth year of St Seraphim Russian Orthodox Youth Camp has been announced. The camp is open to all children of the Russian Orthodox Church and will take place July 27 through August 3, which includes the feast of St Seraphim of Sarov. The cost remains at \$275.00 per child, but will increase to \$300 after July 1, so register early. You may register on line (see below).

Each year, over 200 participate, making the camp the largest youth activity of the Russian Church Abroad. Each day begins with morning prayer and is filled with wonderful activities such as the Law of God, hiking, tube rafting, sports, arts and crafts, and bonfires. Evening prayers end the day. Each campsite is supervised by adult counselors as well as college-aged junior counselors. Several priests spend the entire week at camp, offering counseling, prayers, and instruction. All instruction is in English and services are in both English and Church Slavonic. Vigil and Liturgy are served the final weekend and all children receive the Holy Mysteries.

This is an opportunity for our children to experience summer activities with other Orthodox children from other parishes and leads to life-long friendships. Our Albany and Wilkes-Barre parishes are especially active in the camp. The deadline for camp applications is 1 July but it often fills up fast. Liturgical Notes

White: Before the Divine Liturgy on Holy Saturday morning, 19 April, the red cloths are taken away, and white cloths are laid down. On top of these are the black cloths which will be removed before the Gospel reading at the Liturgy that morning. The white remains until the end of Pentecost week, 29 June.

Carnations: Before the Liturgy on Mother's day, Sunday 11 May, a bunch of carnations are placed in the church for the children of the Church School to hand to the mothers in the parish as they come to kiss the Cross.

Holy Water: Before the Vespers of Mid-Pentecost, Tuesday 13 May, a vat of water is prepared for the Blessing of Waters that will take place at that service.
