Metropolitan's Pastoral Visit: On the occasion of the celebration of our 85th Anniversary, the First Hierarch of the Russian Church Abroad, and our diocesan Arch-Pastor, Metropolitan Hilarion will make a pastoral visit to our parish. He will lead services for our Jubilee, and he will be our Guest of Honor at the Festive Banquet.

Festive Banquet: The St Nicholas 85th Jubilee Banquet will be held at **Vazzano's Four Seasons** (formerly Liedle's), 337 Kenyon St, Stratford CT, from 1:30 to 4:30 pm. The entrees are a choice of Chicken Française, English Cut Prime Rib of Beef, or Broiled Scrod; there will be a cash bar. Entertainment will be by the **St. Petersburg Men's Ensemble** and **Barynya Russian Folk Dancers**. Presentation on the Renovation and Iconography Project. Tickets are \$50 for adults, \$35 for students and seniors, and \$15 for children. Restoration of the Church Interior: In connection with our 85th Jubilee, we are also undertaking a major restoration of the interior of our church. We will replace the faded and peeling paint with fresher colors, brightening up the decorative borders, and restoring the water damaged iconography. We are also adding new mural icons, and have engaged iconographer Oleg Trofimenko to execute the new plan. Proceeds from our Jubilee will go towards the renovation and iconography.

Donations Gratefully Accepted: Donations in any amount will be gratefully accepted for the restoration and painting of icons in the church. Further information will be available soon.

A Word from the Chairman of the Restoration Committee, Gregory Romanovsky

At long last, our parish is beginning the repair and renovation of God's House in anticipation of the 85th year of Russian Orthodoxy at St. Nicholas! We are also undertaking a journey of spirituality as we begin the depiction of Christ's Earthly life on the walls of His House through the hand of iconographer Oleg Trofimenko. This is going to be long project and a large expense.

Our parish funds alone will not cover the repairs that need to be done. We ask that all parishioners contribute what they can. If something in your home needs to be repaired or refurbished you would find a way to pay for it. If you needed a new car you would also find a way to pay for it. For 85 years, Parishioners of St. Nicholas have erected a church and cared for it. Now, God's house is in disrepair. God has given us everything that we have-so shouldn't we thank Him by doing what is right and showing Him how much we love and cherish what He has given to us.

I hope to see all of you at the services over the anniversary weekend. At the banquet I will give a presentation on what Oleg Trofimenko's vision is for the iconography of our beautiful church. I am sure you will be as pleased and amazed as I was when he showed it to me.

We all need to be a part of this journey and contribute from our heart's, knowing that we have made St. Nicholas a beacon that will attract future Orthodox Christians to come and worship in God's House.

Renovations Have Begun! On Monday 22 September renovations in connection with our 85th Jubilee have begun. As of this writing, the peeling paint has been removed, and parts of the ceiling have been primed. This is an ongoing project, and we anticipate the later stages to continue past the 85th Jubilee celebration.

Services

Holy Protection: Vespers for Holy Protection will be at 6:30 pm Monday 13 October. There will be no Divine Liturgy on the day of the Feast, Tuesday 14 October. Those wishing may attend services at the Church of the Presentation of our Lord, 5 Wheeler Terr in Stratford, at 6:30 pm Monday 13 October, and Acahist immediately followed by Divine Liturgy at 8 am Tuesday 14 October. This is also the Parish Feast of our sister parish of the Holy Virgin Protection Church in Nyack, New York, to whom we extend our congratulations, as well as to their Rector, Archpriest George Larin.

Memorial Services: The *Peavy, Wolog. Brockert and Milligan* families will be holding a pannychida after the Divine Liturgy on **Sunday 12 October** in memory of Natalia Wolog and Vladimir (Walter) Brockert. Also to be commemorated are the parents and brother of our Treasurer, Anastasia Milligan. The families invite our parishioners to the memorial meal to be held downstairs in the Church Hall after the pannychida.

On **Sunday 19 October** there will be a litya in memory *Bishop Ioasaph* (Fr Stephan Antonuk), Matushka Elikonida and Olga Antonuk.

St John of Kronstadt: Friday the 31st of October is the eve of St John of Kronstadt. Vespers for the Saint will begin at 6:30 pm.

We will be hosting a Children's Party after Vespers for those families who wish to keep their children off the streets.

Please remember that Halloween is a pagan festival and that trick-or-treating comes from the Druid worship of the dead. Our Christian ancestors suffered martyrdom and torment rather than burn a pinch of incense to the Roman gods, yet many parents willingly let their children participate in a ceremony of pagan worship. Please come and pray in church in honor of a great modern Christian Orthodox Saint whose eve coincides with the pagan Halloween. Parents are welcome to bring lenten treats, board games, juice, and toys to share.

Moleben: To celebrate lesser holy days in October, we will serve a combined moleben to *St Sergius of Radonezh* and *St John the Evangelist and Theologian* at 6:30 pm Wednesday 8 October.

Daylight Time Ends on 1 November: By Act of Congress the start of Daylight Time has been moved from the last Sunday in October to the first Sunday in November. Therefore please set your clocks one hour behind on Saturday night 1 November. It may help to remember which way to set your clock by the saying "Spring Forward, Fall Behind." Since our Metropolitan will be visiting that weekend, we could take the chance to come to church early!

Our Parish

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

Utilities: Please remember that on the *first Sunday* of each month there is a special collection for *utilities*.

Our church needs continuous funding to meet our obligations and to keep up with the utilities.

We also have an introductory rate for students.

Sisterhood

Class begins immediately after Holy Communion, when the teachers lead their pupils downstairs to the church hall. Lessons will continue until after the kissing of the Cross, when Fr George comes downstairs to bless the food. Please enroll your children. Many parents have their children engaged in sports, music and foreign languages; but spiritual education is far more important.

Liturgical Notes

Note: We include this section so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.

Red: Before Vigil on Thursday 25 September the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Red for the Forefeast of Holy Cross. The red cloths are placed over the gold. They remain until the apodosis of the Feast, Saturday 4 October.

Gold: Before Vigil on Saturday 4 October, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Gold (when the red is removed, the gold will show beneath).

Blue: Before Vespers on Monday 13 October, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Blue for the feast of the Protection of the Mother of God.

Gold: On Tuesday evening 14 October, the altar cloths and vestments return to Gold for the balance of the month.
