Metropolitan's Pastoral Visit: On the occasion of the celebration of our 85th Anniversary, the First Hierarch of the Russian Church Abroad, and our diocesan Arch-Pastor, Metropolitan Hilarion will make a pastoral visit to our parish. He will lead services for our Jubilee, and he will be our Guest of Honor at the Festive Banquet.

Festive Banquet: The St Nicholas 85th Jubilee Banquet will be held at **Vazzano's Four Seasons** (formerly Liedle's), 337 Kenyon St, Stratford CT, from 1:30 to 4:30 pm. Services

St John of Kronstadt: Friday the 31st of October is the eve of St John of Kronstadt. Vespers for the Saint will begin at 6:30 pm.

We will be hosting a Children's Party after Vespers for those families who wish to keep their children off the streets.

Please remember that Halloween is a pagan festival and that trick-or-treating comes from the Druid worship of the dead. Our Christian ancestors suffered martyrdom and torment rather than burn a pinch of incense to the Roman gods, yet many parents willingly let their children participate in a ceremony of pagan worship. Please come and pray in church in honor of a great modern Christian Orthodox Saint whose eve coincides with the pagan Halloween. Parents are welcome to bring lenten treats, board games, juice, and toys to share.

Daylight Time Ends on 1 November: By Act of Congress the start of Daylight Time has been moved from the last Sunday in October to the first Sunday in November. Therefore please set your clocks one hour behind on Saturday night 1 November. It may help to remember which way to set your clock by the saying "Spring Forward, Fall Behind." Since our Metropolitan will be visiting that weekend, we could take the chance to come to church early!

No St Demetrius Pannychida This Year: Due to the celebration of the 85th Anniversary of our parish, and the Metropolitan's visit that weekend, we will not have the usual St Demetrius Pannychida this year.

St Nectarios: A service to St Nectarios will be served on Saturday evening 8 November at Christ the Savior Orthodox Church in Southbury to which all parishes are invited (see the announcement under Orthodox Neighbors). We will serve a Moleben to St Nectarios at St Nicholas Church at 3 pm on Saturday 22 November.

Archangel Michael and All Bodiless Powers: Vespers at 6:30 pm Thursday 20 November. No Liturgy on the day of the Feast, Friday 21 November.

Thanksgiving Day: A Service of Thanksgiving will be

served at 9:30 am on Thanksgiving Day, Thursday 27 November. Let us remember why we celebrate this day, and dedicate it to thanking the All-Good Lord for all the benefits He has bestowed on us this past year.

Nativity Fast (Advent): The Nativity Fast begins on Friday 28 November, which is the day after Thanksgiving this year, and continues until Christmas Day, 7 January. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products. On Wednesdays and Fridays we also abstain from fish, wine and oil. Some keep a strict fast Mondays. The fast becomes stricter on the day after St Spyridon and Herman, 25 December, after which we do not eat fish until Christmas Day. If we have leftovers from Thanksgiving, we can put them in the freezer until after Christmas.

Molebens: We will serve a moleben for the lesser holy days in November. Molebens on weeknights will begin at 6:30 pm: Tuesday 4 November for the *Kazan Icon* of the Mother of God; Wednesday 5 November for *St James the Brother of the Lord*; and Monday 24 November for *Great Martyr Menas*. The Molebens to *St Demetrius*, Saturday 8 November; and *St Nectarius* of Pentapolis, Saturday 22 November, will be at 3 pm.

Our Parish

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

Utilities: Please remember that on the *first Sunday* of each month there is a special collection for *utilities*.

Consider the Church in Your Will: Please consider including St Nicholas Church in your will. There are many advantages in making the Church one of your beneficiaries. Collection Box: The collection box next to the icon stand in the middle of the church is for the Restoration Fund and preparations for our 85th Anniversary as a *community*. Our anniversary celebration will be on November 1 and 2.

We also have an introductory rate for students.

Our church needs continuous funding to meet our obligations and to keep up with the utilities.

Red: On Thursday afternoon, 27 November, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Red for the beginning of the Nativity Fast. They remain until the eve of the Feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, Wednesday 3 December.
