### Services

**Nativity Fast (Advent):** The Nativity Fast began on Friday 28 November and continues until Christmas Day, 7 January. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products. On Wednesdays and Fridays we also abstain from fish, wine and oil. Some keep a strict fast Mondays. The fast becomes stricter on the day after Ss Spyridon and Herman, 25 December, after which we do not eat fish until Christmas Day.

**Entry of the Mother of God:** This is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church. Vigil with Litya will be at St Nicho-

las Church at 6:30 pm on Wednesday 3 December. Divine Liturgy will be at Presentation Church, 5 Wheeler Terr here in Stratford at 9 am on Thursday 4 December. This is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church year.

**St Nicholas Day:** Our Parish Feast falls on Friday 19 December. Vigil with Litya will be at 6:30 pm Thursday 18 December; and Divine Liturgy will be at 9:30 am on Friday 19 December. The parish will celebrate with a Fish Dinner after the Liturgy on Sunday 21 December.

**Ss Herman & Spyridon:** This day, which is also secular Christmas, falls on a Thursday. Vespers for Ss Herman and Spyridon will be at 6:30 pm Wednesday 24 December, but there will be no Liturgy on Thursday 25 December.

**Molebens:** We will serve a moleben for the rest of the lesser holy days in December: **Kursk Root Icon** – 6:30 pm Wednesday 10 December; **St Andrew the First-Called** – 3 pm Saturday 13 December; and **St Barbara** – 6:30 pm Wednesday 17 December.

### Our Parish

**St Nicholas Day:** Our Parish Feast falls on Friday 19 December. We will have the traditional St Nicholas Day Fish Dinner after the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 21 December, but we will have Vigil and Divine Liturgy on the eve and the very day of the Feast as mentioned in the Services section of this Bulletin.

**Christmas Flower Donations:** Please make note of the collection box in the center of the church; It its being used for flower donations to make the church beautiful for Christmas.

**Lampada Sponsorship:** Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

**Utilities:** Please remember that on the **first Sunday** of each month there is a special collection for **utilities**.

### St Herman Conference

With the blessing of His Eminence, Metropolitan Hilarion, First Hierarch of the Russian Orthodox Church Outside of Russia, and of His Eminence, Archbishop Gabriel of Montreal and All Canada and Chairman of the St Herman's Executive Committee, the annual St Herman of Alaska Youth Conference will be held from Sunday 21 through Thursday 25 December in *Toronto* Ontario (Canada) at *Holy Trinity Cathedral*. The featured speaker will be *Dr Lynne Pappas*, of the Serbian Orthodox Church, an adolescent psychologist and therapist from northern California. She will speak on the issue of the role of psychology in dealing with contemporary problems facing youth.

The cost for the conference will be a discounted rate of \$275 prior to the November 20<sup>th</sup> deadline and includes lodging, meals, and local transportation. ### Liturgical Notes

*Note: We include this section so that Fr George may help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.*

**Red:** On Thursday afternoon, 27 November, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Red for the beginning of the Nativity Fast. They remain until the eve of the Feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, Wednesday 3 December.

**Blue:** For the feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, we use blue for all altar cloths and vestments from the eve of the Feast, Wednesday 3 December, until the leave-taking of the Feast on Monday 8 December. We also use blue for the Kursk-Root Icon, Tuesday 9 and Wednesday 10 December.

**Red:** On Thursday 11 December we change all altar cloths and vestments to Red for the continuation of the Nativity Fast. The red remains until Christmas Eve, 6 January.

**White:** After Liturgy on Christmas Eve, Tuesday 6 January we change all altar cloths and vestments to white. The white remains until the Apodosis (Leave-Taking) of Theophany, Tuesday 27 January.

**Decorations:** On Christmas Eve, Tuesday 6 January we decorate the church with poinsettias and lights.

### Milestones

**Eternal Memory:** On Thursday 20 November, our long-time parishioner, *Irene Stettin* of Woodmont, reposed at home peacefully in the Lord after a long illness, having received Holy Communion the day before. Her funeral was held at St Nicholas Church by V Rev Archpriest George Lardas on Wednesday 26 November, followed by burial at Novo-Diveevo Convent in Nanuet NY. We ask prayers, especially on her Fortieth Day, Monday 29 November.

May the Lord receive her into His heavenly habitation, where there is neither sickness, nor sorrow, nor sighing, but life everlasting. May her memory be eternal, and may the Lord console her grieving daughter and friends.

**Award:** On Sunday 2 November at the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at St Nicholas Church, in connection with the celebration of the 85<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of our parish, Metropolitan Hilarion awarded the Rector, *Archpriest George Lardas*, the right to wear a *jeweled cross*, and presented him with a mother-of-pearl cross from Jerusalem.
