General Parish Meeting

This year's Annual General Parish Meeting has been moved from Sunday 8 February. It will be held after the Divine Liturgy on **Sunday 29 March** (the Fifth Sunday of Lent). We invite all our members to attend and participate. Please remember that those eligible to vote are those who have confessed and received Communion at least once in the past year and who are up to date in their dues. If you wish to participate, please be sure to fulfill your obligations.

Annual Dues: We ask our parishioners who are not current in their dues please see our Treasurer, Anastasia Milligan. These dues help maintain our parish and give us the privilege of voting and making our voice heard at the Annual Parish Meeting. Donations over and above the dues are also most welcome.

Parish Council Meeting: There will be a meeting of the Parish Council on Sunday 8 March in preparation for the Annual General Parish Meeting to be held on Sunday 29 March. We request all our Parish Council officers to attend.

Election of Parish Officers

Candidates: The current Parish Council was elected last year on Sunday 2 February 2014. The list of candidates for this year's Parish Council Election will be posted at the church before the

meeting.

Inauguration: The new Parish Council to be elected on Sunday 29 March will be inaugurated the following week at the end of the Divine Liturgy on **Palm Sunday, 5 April**. The new Parish Council officers should prepare to receive Holy Communion that day before taking the Oath of Office.

Services

Daylight Time Begins: Please remember that Daylight Time begins at 2 am Sunday 8 March. Please set your clocks ahead one hour on Saturday evening 7 March, so as not to be late for church!

Blessing of Homes: If you missed having your house blessed either due to Fr George's illness or due to snow, or for any other reason, and you still wish your house blessed, please contact Fr George and we will set up an appointment. Availability is as Fr George's schedule allows.

Great Lent: This year Great Lent began on Monday 23 February. During Lent we abstain from meat, eggs, dairy products, and fish. On weekdays we also abstain from wine and oil. Let us also abstain from every sin, and increase our efforts for spiritual growth. We should increase prayer, attendance at the special Lenten services, almsgiving and other deeds of mercy. Lent is given to us to cleanse our hearts and souls in preparation for our Lord's Resurrection.

Lenten Prayer of St Ephraim:

O Lord and Master of my life, a spirit of sloth, despondency, lust of power and idle talk give me not. Prostration.

But rather a spirit of chastity, humility, patience and love bestow upon me, Thy servant. Prostration.

Yea, O Lord and King, grant me to see my own transgressions, and not to judge my brother: For blessed art Thou unto the ages of ages. Amen. Prostration.

Presanctified Liturgy: On Wednesdays of Lent it is customary to serve the Liturgy of the Presanctified Gifts. This year we will hold the Presanctified Liturgy in the morning on some days and in the evening on others.

The Presanctified Liturgy will be held at 6:30 in the *evening*

on Wednesday **4 March**, and at 9:30 in the *morning* on Wednesdays **11 March** and **1 April**.

Those wishing to receive Holy Communion should prepare by prayer, fasting and confession. Confessions will begin half an hour before the start of the Presanctified Liturgy.

Acathist and Lenten Tea: At 6:30 pm on Fridays 6, 13, and 20 March, we will serve the Acathist Hymn to the Most Holy Theotokos. Each of those days we will sing a quarter of the Acathist to the Most Holy Mother of God with Small Compline. On the fifth Friday of Lent, 27 March, we will serve the entire Acathist service with Matins. The first four Acathist services will be followed by tea and a spiritual discussion.

Sunday of Orthodoxy: A short moleben and procession of icons to celebrate the Triumph of Orthodoxy and the Restoration of the Icons will immediately follow the Divine Liturgy on the Sunday of Orthodoxy, 1 March.

Soul Saturdays: The 2nd, 3rd and 4th Saturdays of Great Lent are appointed for general commemoration of the dead. Accordingly, a General Pannychida will be served on Saturdays 7, 14 and 21 March.

We will read the names of the reposed from all the Commemoration Books (*Pomjanniki*) at the Candle Desk. If you wish to add any names to the commemoration of the reposed, please leave your list at the Candle Desk on the Sunday before.

Pan-Orthodox Vespers

The Pan-Orthodox Lenten Vespers are sponsored by the Greater Bridgeport Orthodox Clergy Association and are held at various Orthodox churches in the Bridgeport area. The Vespers are every Sunday afternoon during Lent. This year's schedule is as follows. *All services are at 4 pm:*

1st Sunday: March 1, *Holy Trinity Greek Church*, 4070 Park Ave, Bridgeport

2nd Sunday: March 8, *St George's Albanian Church*, 5090 Main St, Trumbull

3rd Sunday: March 15, *St Nicholas Antiochian Church*, 5458 Park Ave, Bridgeport

4th Sunday: March 22, *St Nicholas Russian Church*, 1 Honeyspot Rd, Stratford

5th Sunday: March 29, *OCA Connecticut Deanery Holy Unction Service, Three Saints Church*; 26 Howard Ave, Ansonia

Palm Sunday: April 5, *Bridegroom Matins, Holy Transfiguration Church*, 285 Alden St, New Haven

Shortage of Prosporas: We were nearly out of prosporas on Sunday 22 February, and so none were given out at the Divine Liturgy on that day. Fortunately we had a volunteer, Tatiana Stettinin, who baked prosporas, so that we have enough for the first three weeks of March. We are looking for more volunteers. Without prosporas we cannot serve the Divine Liturgy.

Our Parish

Spring Cleaning: On Sunday March 8 after the Parish Council meeting there will be a quick preliminary cleanup in preparation for a more thorough spring cleaning at a time to be announced, probably Saturday 21 March. We ask all our parish organizations to label or notify Fr George or our Starosta, Dexter Peavy, of anything that you wish to keep. Unclaimed items will be discarded.

Flowers for the Plaschanitsa: Starting mid-March the collection box next to the icon stand in the middle of the church is for flowers for the Plaschanitsa and for Pascha.



Call for Pussy Willows: Palm Sunday is 5 April this year. We ask all our parishioners to cut pussy willows when they come into bloom (which may be late this year due to the snowy winter), and bring them to church to put with others that we are keeping for Palm Sunday. Until you bring them to church, please keep them in a cool, dark place so that they stay fresh. We will need the pussy willows by Saturday afternoon (3 pm) 4 April.

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting of the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. The sponsorship of the lampadas is \$25 for all the lampadas in the church. Register at the Candle Desk if you wish to sponsor the lampadas, in whole or in part, on a Sunday of your choice.

Utilities: Please remember that on the *first Sunday* of each month there is a special collection for *utilities*.

ST. NICHOLAS PASCHAL EVENTS FOR CHILDREN:

Sunday of Orthodoxy: Our Church School will participate in a short moleben at the end of the Divine Liturgy on 1 March, the First Sunday of Great Lent. This celebrates the Triumph of Orthodoxy and the Restoration of the Icons. This replaces the regular classes of that day.

Lenten retreat - Saturday 28 March at 3:00 (*note the time with Vigil beginning at 5 pm*). Ages 3 and up. Fr George will give a talk, and the children will watch a film that pertains to Lent and Pascha, make a craft, and practice the Paschal troparion. Children will have a pot-luck supper at 4:30 and stay for Vespers; older children may go to Confession. Please enter your child's name at the Candle Desk.

St Nicholas Annual Children's Communion Breakfast – Sunday 29 March after Holy Communion. All children are invited to a festive breakfast during Coffee Hour. Parents needed to bring and prepare light breakfast fare.

Divine Liturgy – Holy Saturday, 11 April – Older children are invited to do readings. Please see Matushka Ann for a reading assignment.

Children's Paschal Liturgy – Bright Monday, 13 April – Children carry icons during the procession (*krestnyj khod*) around the church, followed by an *Easter egg hunt and lamb dinner for all parishioners*.

Sunday of Orthodoxy: Our Church School will participate in a short moleben at the end of the Divine Liturgy on 1 March, the First Sunday of Great Lent. This celebrates the Triumph of Orthodoxy and the Restoration of the Icons. This replaces the regular classes of that day.

Food Drive: The Food Drive for the Sterling House Food Pantry will resume during Lent. Our Church School will lead this effort. We ask the parents in our parish to help out by sending food, canned goods and hygienic supplies with their children when they come to church. Please remember that during Lent we should increase our almsgiving, and this is one way to help the poor. If each of us brings one or two items, we should be able to fill several bags each week.

Sisterhood

We Appreciate Donations of Coffee Hour Supplies: The Sisterhood is always in need of donations of supplies for our Coffee Hour. We need *paper plates, Styrofoam soup bowls, cups, and paper napkins. We are particularly in need of food storage and ziplock bags.* We also need food supplies and willing hands to help prepare, set things up and clean up. Please remember the parish when you are shopping, and see Joan Hudobenko if you wish to help. We thank you for your continued support, and appreciate all your donations.

Another need is *paper towels and toilet paper* for the bathrooms and kitchen.

Choir

Come, Join the Choir: With Lent, we have many, many more services, and we will need people to sing both by day and by night. We are grateful to have children singing at the Liturgy, and encourage our parishioners to help when they can by joining the Choir! Chesnokov says that it takes at least three people per part to sustain a Russian choir – two to sing and one to breathe, taking turns. If you want to come and first stand and observe, and then join in slowly, that's okay, generations have learned this way.

Chronicle

Bliny and Snow: Our annual Pre-Lenten *Bliny* on Sunday 15 February was nearly cancelled by yet more bad weather (very icy). However, enough people were able to come to church so that we could hold the *Bliny* dinner. The leftovers were used for the make-up date Tuesday evening, 17 February, which was still *Maslenitsa* (Butter Week). The remainder were sold as take-out.

Liturgical Notes

Note: *We include this section so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.*

Black: We use black from Sunday nights through Friday afternoons of Lent. While the black cloths are used, the red ones are hidden underneath for the next Lenten weekend services.

Dark Red or Purple: The altar cloths and vestments are red from Friday evenings through Sunday evenings of Lent, purple vestments may be used as well. While the red cloths are used, the black ones are hidden underneath for the next Lenten weekday service.

Flowers for the Cross: On Saturday afternoon 14 March we place the hand Cross on a dish and decorate it with red carnations and basil leaves in preparation for the Adoration of the Cross at Vigil that evening.

Blue: On the first four Fridays evenings of Lent in addition to the red coverings, we put blue on the analogion in the middle of the church holding the icon of the Theotokos. The reading stand and the Holy Table are also covered with blue, and blue vestments are used. On the fifth Friday evening of Lent the black coverings are changed to red, and the blue are laid over them.

Before Vigil on Saturday 28 March, the coverings are changed back to red.

Milestones

Eternal Memory: On Saturday 31 January, our long-time parishioner, *Martin Hudobenko*, aged 85, of Ansonia reposed quietly in the Lord at home attended by his family. His funeral was served on Wednesday 4 February by V Rev George Lardas, Rector, at Jenkins, King and Malerba Funeral Home in Ansonia, assisted by Rev Deacon Paul Giatas with a choir from St Nicholas Church in the presence of our parishioners. Her funeral was served by Rev David Cochran of St John the Baptist Orthodox Church in Bridgeport assisted by Rev Deacon Paul Giatas at Cyril Mullins Funeral Home in Trumbull on Friday 20 February with a choir from St Nicholas Church in the presence of our parishioners. Burial followed at Lakeview Cemetery in Bridgeport. We ask prayers for her repose, especially on her Fortieth Day, Sunday 29 March.

We also ask prayers for *Zinaida Kuskin*, the mother of Olga Pivazyan, who reposed on Saturday 7 February at St Raphael's Hospital in New Haven. Her Fortieth Day is Wednesday 18 March.

On Sunday 1 March, *Fr Matthew Baker*, recently assigned as Rector of the Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church in Norwich was killed as he lost control of his car after leaving church for home. His six small children, ages 2 through 11 were with him in the car, but miraculously survived. Though he had been at Holy Trinity Church for a short time, he and his family were much beloved. May the Lord receive them into His heavenly habitation, where there is neither sickness, nor sorrow, nor sighing, but life everlasting. May their memory be eternal, and may the Lord console their grieving family and friends.
