Services

Paschal Vespers: There will be no Divine Liturgy on Pascha Day itself, Sunday 1 May, since it will have already been served earlier, in the middle of the night. Instead, Paschal Vespers will be served at the usual time of the Sunday service, 10 am.

Bright Monday: Divine Liturgy for the second day of Pascha will begin at 10 am Monday 2 May. This service is for those children (and others) who cannot come to the Midnight Service on Pascha, and will include a procession by the children with Icons, a festive Trapeza, and an Easter egg hunt.

St George's Day and the Life-Giving Fount: We will serve Vespers for St George and for the Life-Giving Fount of the Mother of God on Thursday of Bright Week, 5 May, beginning at 6:30 pm.

Blessing of Graves: This will be on St Thomas Sunday and Monday of St Thomas Week:

- **Sunday 8 May** – 2:30 pm, *St Joseph's Cemetery* in Lordship; 3:30 pm, *Union Cemetery* in Stratford; and 4:30 pm, *St John's Cemetery* in Stratford.
- **Monday 9 May** – 4:00 pm, *Old Milford Cemetery*; 5:00 pm, *King's Highway Cemetery* in Milford.
- **Tuesday 10 May** – 3:00 pm, *St John's Cemetery* in Monroe; 5:00 pm, *Lakeview Cemetery* in Bridgeport.

At the appointed time we will serve a general Pannychida at the Chapel (St John's), at the flagpole in the middle of the cemetery (King's Highway), at the main entrance (Lakeview), or at the main Cross (St John's Monroe), and then we will bless the individual graves. If you cannot be present for the blessing of a grave at the stated time, or if you have a loved one buried elsewhere, you can arrange to have Fr George bless a grave at another time.

Mid-Pentecost: Vespers for Mid-Pentecost will be at 6:30 pm Tuesday 24 May, and will be followed immediately by the *Lesser Blessing of Waters.*

Translation of the Relics of St Nicholas: This celebrates the transfer of the Relics of our Patron Saint from Myra in Asia Minor (now Turkey) to Bari, Italy, to keep them in the hands of the faithful, and to protect them from the enemies of the Church.

Announcements – March 2016

This feast falls on Sunday 22 May. Vigil with Litya begins at 5 pm Saturday 21 May, and Divine Liturgy is at 10 am Sunday 22 May. As a feast of St Nicholas, it is the secondary Feast of our Parish. We have the actual Relic of our own Patron Saint, which will be set out for veneration.

Memorial Day: In observance of Memorial Day, Monday 30 May, we will have a short Memorial Service (Litya) at the end of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday 29 May for all Orthodox soldiers that died in battle, and we also ask our parishioners to remember in their private prayers all non-Orthodox who perished and gave their lives for the defense of freedom, and that the Lord may have mercy on them. Please remember to display the flag Monday.

Lesser Holy Days: To celebrate lesser holy days in May, we will serve molebens at the following times: *St John the Evangelist and Theologian*, 3 pm Saturday 21 May; and the *Ss Cyril and Methodius*, 6:30 pm Monday 23 May.

Blessing of Homes: If Fr. George was unable to bless your home before Lent and you still wish to have your house blessed, please contact Fr George and set up an appointment.

Our Children

End of Church School and Picnic: This will take place on the 7th Sunday of Pascha (Sunday of the 1st Ecumenical Council), 12 June after the Divine Liturgy. We ask all Church School children and their teachers to attend. We will also congratulate all graduates in our parish from all schools or colleges. If you have children in school and wish to have their names commemorated, please submit them to the Candle Desk by the end of the Liturgy of that day. With fair weather, we will hold our Coffee Hour outside.

Prospora Baking

Calling for Prospora Bakers: On Sunday 8 May, St Thomas Sunday, we will only have enough prosporas to serve the Proskomedie (preparation of the Communion), but none to give out to the people. Without prosporas we cannot serve the Liturgy. We have a continuing need for prosporas and prospora bakers. We use about 30 to 35 each Sunday, so we need approximately 150 a month. We are therefore looking for one or more volunteers to make prosporas on a regular basis.

Prospora Baking: We will hold a prospora baking party in the kitchen at the church on Friday 13 May beginning at 9:30 am.

Summer Camp

St Seraphim's Orthodox Summer Camp: The twenty-first year of St Seraphim Russian Orthodox Youth Camp has been announced. The camp is open to all children of the Russian Orthodox Church and will take place from 31 July through 7 August, which includes the feast of St Seraphim of Sarov. The cost remains at \$275 per child, but will increase to \$300 after July 1, so register early. You may register on line (see below).

Each year, over 200 participate, making the camp the largest youth activity of the Russian Church Abroad. Each day begins with morning prayer and is filled with wonderful activities such as the Law of God, hiking, tube rafting, sports, arts and crafts, and bonfires. Evening prayers end the day. Each campsite is supervised by adult counselors as well as college-aged junior counselors. Several priests spend the entire week at camp, offering counseling, prayers, and instruction. All instruction is in English and services are in both English and Church Slavonic. Vigil and Liturgy are served the final weekend and all children receive the Holy Mysteries.

This is an opportunity for our children to experience summer activities with other Orthodox children from other parishes and leads to life-long friendships. Our Albany and Wilkes-Barre parishes are especially active in the camp. The deadline for camp applications is 1 July but it often fills up fast. Liturgical Notes

Note: We include this section so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.

White: Before the Divine Liturgy on Holy Saturday morning, 23 April, the red cloths are taken away, and white cloths are laid down. On top of these are the black cloths which will be removed before the Gospel reading at the Liturgy that morning. The white remains until the end of Pentecost week, Saturday 25 June.

Carnations: Before the Liturgy on Mother's day, Sunday 8 May, a bunch of carnations are placed in the church for the children of the Church School to hand to the mothers in the parish as they come to kiss the Cross.

Holy Water: Before the Vespers of Mid-Pentecost, Tuesday 24 May, a vat of water is prepared for the Blessing of Waters that will take place at that service.
