Services

Nativity Fast (Advent): The Nativity Fast began on Monday 28 November, and continues until Christmas Day, 7 January. During this time we abstain from meat, eggs and dairy products. On Wednesdays and Fridays we also abstain from fish, wine and oil. Some keep a strict fast Mondays. The fast becomes stricter on the day after Ss Spyridon and Herman, 25 December, after which we do not eat fish until Christmas Day. The fast begins the Monday after Thanksgiving this year, which allows us time to finish or freeze any leftovers.

Entry of the Mother of God: This is one of the Twelve Great Feasts of the Church. Vigil with Litya will be at 5 pm Saturday 3 December, and Divine Liturgy at 10 am on Sunday 5 December (the usual time).

Hierarchical Divine Liturgy: His Grace, *Bishop Nicholas (Olhovsky) of Manhattan* will serve with us on *Sunday before St Nicholas Day, 18 December*, in honor of our Parish Feast. The Meeting of the Bishop will be at 9:30 am, followed by the beautiful service of the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at 10 am. Bishop Nicholas will be our guest of honor at the Festive Trapeza to follow.

St Nicholas Day: Although Bishop Nicholas' visit to honor our St Nicholas Parish Feast is on Sunday 18 December, we will also hold services for St Nicholas on the actual day of his commemoration. Vigil with Litya will be at 6:30 pm Sunday 18 December; and Divine Liturgy for the Feast will be at 7:30 am (*early service, note the time!*) Monday 19 December.

Molebens: We will serve a moleben for the lesser holy days in December: *St Catherine* – 6:30 pm Wednesday 7 December;

Kursk Root Icon – 3 pm Saturday 10 December; *St Andrew the First-Called* – 6:30 pm Tuesday 13 December; and *St Barbara* – 3 pm Saturday 17 December.

Secular New Year: We will *not be holding Vigil* at St Nicholas on secular New Year's Eve. We ask our parishioners to *attend the service at the Church of the Presentation* of our Lord in the Temple, at 6:30 pm Saturday 31 December. *Services for Sunday 1 January, secular New Year's Day, will be announced.*

Administrative

Lampada Sponsorship: Offerings may be made to sponsor the lighting of the lampadas at the Divine Liturgy, either in memory of loved ones, or in gratitude for blessings received, or for any other good intention. Liturgical Notes

Note: We include this section so that Fr George may have help changing the altar cloths and vestments at the appropriate times. This is a lot of work, but goes much more easily with a few helping hands.

Red: On Sunday afternoon, 27 November, the altar cloths and vestments are changed to Red for the beginning of the Nativity Fast. They remain until the eve of the Feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, Saturday 3 December.

Blue: For the feast of the Entry of the Mother of God into the Temple, we use blue for all altar cloths and vestments from the

eve of the Feast, Saturday 3 December, until the leave-taking of the Feast on Thursday 8 December. We also use blue for the Kursk-Root Icon, Friday 9 and Saturday 10 December.

Red: On Saturday evening 10 December we change all altar cloths and vestments to Red for the continuation of the Nativity Fast. The red remains until Christmas Eve, Friday 6 January.

White: Before the Vigil on Christmas Eve, Friday 6 January we change all altar cloths and vestments to white. The white remains until the Apodosis (Leave-Taking) of Theophany, Friday 27 January.

Decorations: On Christmas Eve, Friday 6 January we decorate the church with poinsettias and lights.
